Note for Conundrum

The deviser, Brenda Burnell, prefers that we dance her original version of The Conundrum, rather than the version published in the RSCDS Leeds 10th Anniversary Book. This varies in respect of the last three bars and the last sentence referring to bars 25 to 32 reads:-

On bar 30. **whilst unwinding from the allemande**, the 3rd and 4th men turn their partners round in front of them $\frac{3}{4}$ so they are facing each other in the middle, each with their backs to their own side of the dance, ready to retire on bars 31 and 32 in straight lines with the other dancers.
