Basic Teaching Skills Course

The RSCDS has recently introduced a short teaching skills course to help people who give instruction to Scottish Dance groups. Each participant will receive a Record of Completion at the end of the course.

A two day course is being arranged by the York and North Humberside Branch on two Sundays in 2011: 20 March and 3 April, from 10.00-4.30. The tutor will be Helen Russell.

The sessions will be in the Dunnington Reading Room, just off the southern section of the York bypass.
