


- **1–6** Reel of three on the sides, 1s crossing
- **7–8** 1s dance down to face 3m, promenade hold, 2c dance to 1st place
- **9–16** 1s dance R Sh reel of three with 2nd corners
- 17–24 1s dance L Sh reel of three with 1st corners
- 24–32 1s cross down between 3s, cast up to 2nd place, dance up between 2s, cast to 2nd place own sides

- 1- 1c+2c RHA; LHA
- 9- 1c dance down the middle (2c up); and up to face 1cnrs
- 17- 1c set to and turn corners, finish between corners
- **25–** LSh Reels3(6) on the sides, 1c cross RH (2,1,3)

- 1- All Circle8 and back
- 9- Double L chain (women ½ RHA, turn opposite M LH; ½ RHA, turn P LH, to own places)
- 17- 1c+3c Reel4, (W pass left shoulder, M set on [17-18], at the end W slow down and M speed up, face and acknowledge P and pull back inner shoulder to face corners.
- 25- All set to corner H.Schottische; turn cnr BH twice

  - **49–** Women Circle4 L (at end pull back Rsh to face out); set to and turn P BH.
  - 57- Men circle4 R, pull back Lsh; set to and turn P BH.
  - **65–** G-Chain (one step per hand)
  - **73** Promenade cclw round the set in Allemande hold, M bring W into middle of set and hold RH for bow and curtsey

- 25-40 1½Reel3 on own side (2W starts out and down) {12 bars}; 1W+2W turn LH 1½ (to 2,1,3)
  - **41** stand



- 9-48 the M repeat the W's movements in mirror image 8 bars later, giving RH on [19-20].-On [28] the M pass just below their P who is 4 bars into the reel, and face up .

- 1- 1c cross RH | cast off (2c up); cross LH | cast L (W up, M down)

- 17- 1c NHJ set to 2W (swivel ½ inwards), set to 3M (veer L together), set to 3W (swivel ½ inwards), set to 2M (and face own 2cnr)



- 9- 1W+2c & 1M+3c set twice in lines across, but on [11–12] 1c Petronella to opposite sideline; all set twice on sidelines (2,1x,3)




- 17- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back
- **25** Reels3(6) on the sides (Rsh to 2cnr) | 1c cross (2,1,3)

- 9-1c Rsh 1/2 Reel3 with 2M+3M; Rsh ½Reel3 with 3W+2W, 1c finish in centre facing 3W (now in 1W pl)



17-1c set to 3W pulling Rsh back | set to 2W; set to 2M | 1c set to 3M while{2} 3c+2c set advancing into



## Part A

- All C circle8 and back
- 9-1W+2W+3W+4W RHA, holding P LH; all C veer right NHJ to bring M to the middle for LHA back to places, M holding P RH.
- 17-All C set to partners twice; turn partners once BH, to finish facing partners in original places



All C G-Chain (2 skip change par hand) to own places, finishing facing the centre (no polite turn) 25-40

## Part B

- 1-1W moves to centre, and dances alone (any suitable reel steps) while (8) 1M+2c+3c+4c circle7 and back
- 9-1W sets to and turns P BH; sets to and turns opposite M (3M) BH
- 17-1W+1M+3M Reel3, 1W starts with Lsh to 1M, 1W stays in the centre at the end
- 25-Repeat bars 1-8
- 33-1W sets to and turns M on right (4M) BH; sets to and turns opposite M (2M) BH
- 1W+4M+2M Reel3, 1W starts with Lsh to 4M, at the end 1W resumes her original place, and 2W 41moves into the centre

Repeat part B 7 times, with 2W, 3W, 4W, 1M, ... 4M each in turn in the centre. On bars 9- the W/M in the centre first sets to the P, then to the opposite M/W. In bars 33- the W/M first sets to the M/W on the L (seen from inside) of her/his original position, then the M/W opposite. repeat part A



- 21-24 1M+2M turn LH while 1L+2L turn RH, 2s+1s+3s set
- **25-32** 2s+1s+3s circle round & back

- 17- 1c mirror Fig8 round 2c&3c, starting in (join NH when meeting) (to 1,2,3)



- 17- BiL with 2cnrs | ½ turn 2cnrs LH; 1c followed by 2cnrs chase cclw, 1c crossing Lsh to 2plx facing out (3x,1x, 2x)







- 9- 1c ½Reel4 with 1cnrs (pass P Lsh); Repeat with 2cnrs
- 17- Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); Repeat with 4cnrs (2cnr person)
- 25- 1W+2c & 1M+3c Reels3 across, Lsh to 1cnr
- 33- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back



Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9-24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and sometimes nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".


